

Alberta Star Party Breakfast

Volunteers needed (3-7 people)

- 1 for set up
- 3 for cooking
- 2 for washing and drying
- 1 for clean up/tear down

Set up 9:15-9:30 for a 10am,

Pancake batter ready, water being boiled and sausages cooking by 9:45
9:45-10am cook pancakes (cooked pancakes in the warming container).
Breakfast from 10am to 10:30am. Seconds can be served after 10:30am

Do not keep the tickets as they are for accounting purposes only.

Food for sixty people (3 sausages and 3 pancakes per person)

Sausages can be done weeks before the ASP, buy them on sale. Maple Leaf breakfast sausages, remove from packaging and put in aluminum metal trays (size that will fit on a camp stove or table top BBQ) cover with aluminum foil. Place in freezer. Remove from freezer by Saturday noon before the breakfast.

Juice -6 liters 4 boxes of orange 2 of apple
pancake mix (just add water) -4 boxes of 1 kg
water (10 liters of drinking water)
coffee instant
sugar
coffee whitener or creamer
stir sticks
juice drinking cups (60)
foam cups (60 small)
syrup -3 bottles
napkins
non-stick spray

Any of the coffee related material can be given to the Second Vice President for use at the general meetings. Unopened food can be donated to the food bank.

When people register they will be told to bring their own chairs, plates and cutlery

For food preparation and serving, two picnic tables or one picnic table and one folding table

Require 4 camp stoves or 3 camp stoves and one table top BBQ (recommended), one of these camp stoves for boiling water for coffee and clean up.

Alberta Star Party Breakfast

2 griddles that fit on the camp stoves, kettles to boil water for coffee. Oven mittens.
Matches or propane lighters.

Mixing bowls for pancake mix, spatulas, pancake flippers, whisk and tongs for
serving pancakes and sausages.

For holding cooked pancakes a small roasting pan or other lidded container that is
heat resistant and can be put on BBQ to keep warm. This container sometimes gets
knocked to the ground.

Dish washing pan, soap, and washing cloth, dish towels.

plastic garbage bags and some way to secure it open (tape or something)
